## Canada Energy Regulator (CER) <br> Pre-Construction Audit - TransCanada Keystone Pipeline GP Ltd. (Keystone) Corrective and Preventative Action (CAPA) Plan Audit Close-out Letter

In accordance with subsection 49(3) of the National Energy Board Act, subsequently subsection 103(3) of the Canadian Energy Regulator Act, the CER conducted a compliance audit of the Keystone project starting on 8 February 2019. The audit examined aspects of Keystone's management system as it related to planned future construction activities. The key objective of the audit was to verify that Keystone had developed a Management System as required by the Canadian Energy Regulator Onshore Pipeline Regulations for the effective management of the hazards and associated risks of its facilities and activities during the construction phase of the Keystone project.

The CER issued its Final Audit Report (Report) to Keystone on 6 February 2020.
